Girls globally are not in school, leaving them with little formal education to support themselves and their families.

The Method

- **Equip** mothers so they can start their own businesses, send their children to school, and provide for their families.
- Educate girls so they can make good choices for their futures, such as staying in school, delaying marriage, and pursuing job opportunities.
- **Empower** women and girls through education so they can know their value and find sustainable solutions that will change the course of their lives and impact generations to come.

The Impact

90% of earnings by women are reinvested back into their households toward nutrition, food, health care, school, and incomegenerating activities.

Thousands of families are receiving hope for a brighter future as the generational cycle of poverty is broken.

64,282 women and girls have been trained since 2010, but countless more need opportunities for a better way of life.

16 countries now have Women's **Empowerment** programming.

Tanzania Women's Empowerment

Dorcas' story began with her marriage to a successful businessman. After her husband was tragically killed in a plane crash, her world began



to spiral downward. Her in-laws disowned her. She was thrust into severe poverty and could not support her children.

On a trip to Tanzania, we met Dorcas. With grace and humility, she told us how difficult her life had been through a waterfall of tears. Fortunately, she found her way to our Women's Empowerment program.

About 18 months later, we returned to Tanzania. We didn't even recognize Dorcas. Her face was full of joy and confidence. She owned a successful jewelry business and was feeding her kids. Dorcas' future and the future of her children are bright and filled with hope.
