Women are taught how to earn income to feed more families.



Sophie's Story

Sophie, once the owner of a lucrative farm in Kenya, watched her success come crashing down when a devastating drought robbed her of her ability to provide for her family.

"There was no rain. The people left our area," Sophie said. "They were moving their cattle to other places that weren't so dry. My customers were gone and my crops wouldn't grow."

The drought took a toll on Sophie's land, her business, and her family. She watched her livestock die and began to worry how she would feed her children.

"With no rain, my business collapsed," said Sophie.

Sophie had previously participated in Convoy of Hope's Women's Empowerment program in Kenya. She learned how to save money, how to lead a successful business, and how to maintain hope and positive values.

"I had gained confidence in running a business and I knew I could do it again," she said.





So Sophie soon started a new business: a gas station. Her new business boomed in ways a farm never could during a drought. Sophie was, once again, providing for her family and others in her community.



QUICK TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- We recommend that leadership engage with the *One Day to Empower Women* campaign.
 When you express your heart for the poor and suffering, you will send a powerful message about the DNA of your church.
- Choose the length of your campaign. We recommend 2 to 3 weeks. Consider using a holiday, such as Easter, Mother's Day, Thanksgiving, or even Super Bowl Sunday.
- For free materials and other resources, go to convoy.org/oneday-women to register.
- Set a goal for everyone to participate! As you know, your church members will likely rise to any challenge your leadership sets for them. If your church held a fundraiser last year, consider asking them to meet or exceed what they gave last year.

- Encourage your church to choose a specific day at work to wear their *One Day* sticker. Our hope is that it sparks opportunities to share with others about the good work they are doing through Convoy of Hope.
- Give the entire congregation an update on how much was raised following your campaign. Celebrate the good work you did together!

4-WEEK SERIES EXAMPLE

WEEK 1

- Show a video.
- Distribute the handouts and stickers.
- Ask your church members to consider giving.
- Announce the giving date.

WEEK 2

- Show another video.
- Ask your congregation to share why your church cares about empowering women within their circles of influence.
- Remind them of the giving date.

WEEK 3

- Show a third video.
- Distribute giving envelopes.
- Collect the donations.

WEEK 4

- Announce how much your church generously gave.
- Celebrate the difference they made!
