General Track Description

The U.S. Program Intern will work closely with smaller working groups within the U.S. Program Team: Church Engagement, Community Care, Field Teams, and Volunteer Engagement. The U.S. Program Intern should have an interest in the faith-based ministry of Convoy of Hope and will be invited to attend chapel services and prayer.

Desired Learning Outcomes

- 1. Students will appropriately define poverty and identify strategies to alleviate poverty and eliminate hopelessness.
- 2. Students will effectively communicate with a team and in interdisciplinary contexts.
- 3. Students will understand the importance of Asset Based Community Development and be able to perform Asset Based Community Assessments.
- 4. Students will gain experience in nonprofit humanitarian work.
- 5. Students will recognize and demonstrate insightful, strategic compassion.
- 6. Students will advocate for the vulnerable, the poor, and the suffering.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- 1. Researches demographics in Convoy of Hope event cities and Field Team locations
- 2. Attends and participates in weekly team (staff) meetings
- 3. Assists with preparation for community events and engagements
- 4. Studies and learns concepts related to community transformation
- 5. Contacts partners to gather information, including stats, stories, and feedback
- 6. Participates in selected team leader trainings or calls with local church leaders
- 7. Tours local partner ministries
- 8. Assists with special projects as assigned by the U.S. Program teams

- 2. Excellent problem-solving skills
- 3. Strong attention to detail
- 4. Proficiency with computers
- 5. Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- 6. Ability to work collaboratively in a team environment
