General Track Description

The Children's Feeding Intern will work closely with International Program, as well as collaborate with other teams around the organization as needed. The Children's Feeding Intern should have an interest in health, nutrition, and food insecurity. Interns should also have an interest in the faith-based ministry of Convoy of Hope and will be invited to attend chapel services and prayer.

Desired Learning Outcomes

1. Students will engage in real-world experiences that connect academic knowledge with food insecurity and nutrition challenges around the world.
2. Students will develop and strengthen professional skills such as communication, collaboration, and cultural competence while working with diverse populations affected by food insecurity.
3. Students will understand and apply the Asset-Based Community Development (ABCD) model through engagement with Convoy of Hope's International Program initiatives.
4. Students will recognize and demonstrate insightful, strategic compassion.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

1. Conducts research and plans for strategy-based projects
2. Creates presentations, spreadsheets, and documents
3. Observes field calls
4. Collaborates with other International Program team specialists
5. Assists with special projects as assigned by the International Program team
6. Assists with other general tasks as assigned

4. Ability to remain flexible while working with multiple projects
